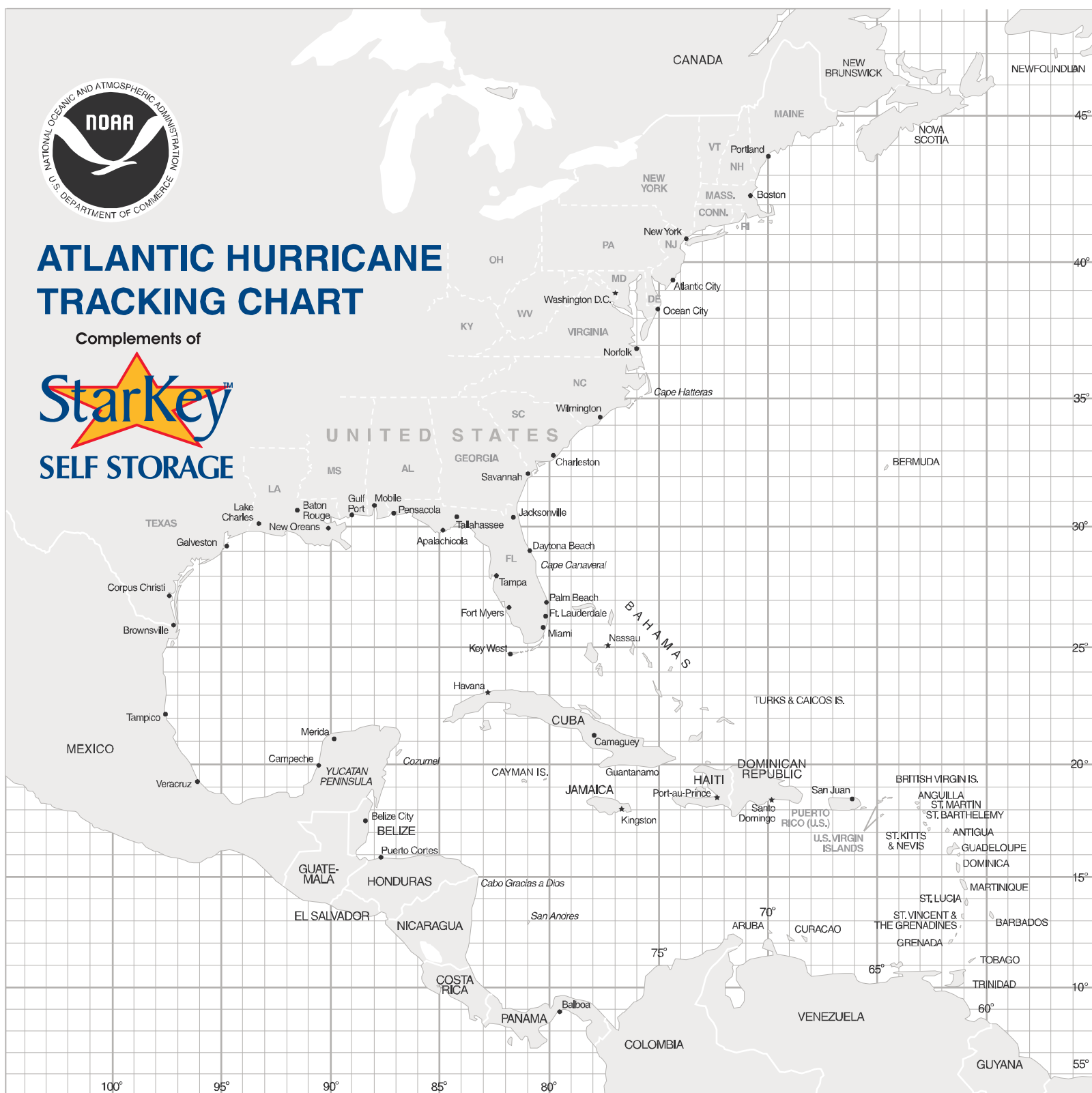




# ATLANTIC HURRICANE TRACKING CHART

### Storm Warnings

**Hurricane:** An intense tropical system with a well-defined circulation and maximum sustained winds of 74 mph or higher.

**Tropical Storm:** An organized system of strong thunderstorms with a defined circulation and maximum sustained winds of 39 to 73 mph.

**Tropical Depression:** An organized system of clouds and thunderstorms with a defined circulation and maximum sustained winds of 38 mph or less.

**Hurricane Warning:** Hurricane conditions are expected within 24 hours.

**Hurricane Watch:** Hurricane conditions are possible usually within 36 hours.

**Tropical Storm Warning:** Tropical Storm conditions are expected usually within 24 hours.

**Tropical Storm Watch:** Tropical Storm conditions are possible usually within 36 hours.

### Safety Tips

- Stock up on canned food and other non-perishables.
- Check supplies of medicines, drugs, and diapers.
- Secure lawn furniture and other loose material outdoors.
- Board or shutter windows to prevent shattering.
- Check other general supply items such as candles, matches, fire extinguishers, first-aid kits, tools, insect repellents, can openers, batteries, blankets, and work boots.
- Fill up your car.
- Move valuables to upper floors and bring in pets.
- Turn up refrigerator to maximum cold and do not open unless necessary.
- Shut off gas, water, and electricity at main stations. Copy important documents. Store originals in a safe place.
